The New Brunswick Building Officials Association will be offering a five-day training session called "Part 9 – Technical Book 2" January 12 – January 16, 2009 at the Ramada Plaza Crystal Palace Hotel, 499 Paul Street, Dieppe, NB (Tel: (506) 858-8584). Registration begins at 8:15 a.m., January 12th with regular course hours from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. **No payments will be accepted upon registration. All payments shall be made prior to cut-off date.**

This 5-day course deals with:

- the design and verification of fire-resistance ratings;
- requirements for fire separations because of building classification;
- separation of major occupancies;
- service spaces, exits, including penetrations of fire separations, means of egress and exit facilities;
- fire protection and suppression including methods for rough-in, interior layout and interior/ exterior inspections; and
- a plans examination module

You must have "The House" and "Part 9 Technical Book 1" certification courses as prerequisites for admittance to this training session.

The cost will be \$450 for NBBOA paid members and \$610 for non-members. All payments made to NBBOA P.O. Box 3193, Station B Fredericton, NB E3A 5G9. The 1995 NBCC, pen, calculator, etc. are the individual participant's responsibility. This course is required for Level 2 of the NBBOA Certification Program.
