Retired members shall enjoy all the rights and privileges of Regular Members, but shall not have the right to vote or to hold Executive office.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	(E)	<p>Student Members: \$50 + HST Student membership is granted to an individual who is enrolled full time in a program in New Brunswick relating to the design and construction of buildings at a recognized post-secondary institution. Student Members shall enjoy all rights and privileges of Regular Members but shall not have the right to vote or hold office. Proper Student I.D is required.</p>

Associate Members shall enjoy all rights and privileges of regular members but shall not have the right to vote or to hold office.</p>
